

Coton Countryside Reserve Rules

Please read and follow the rules below. They help to make this green space a happy and safer place for everyone to visit, and help to protect wildlife.

1. **Cars, motorbikes & other motorised vehicles** (except disabled buggies) must only use the visitor car park.
2. **Camping and overnight stays of any vehicle, including caravans**, is not permitted.
3. **Dogs** must be kept under strict control and on leads at all times, to protect wildlife, grazing animals, and fellow visitors, unless using the designated **Dog Run** near the Coton Footpath ¹.
4. **Clean up after your dogs** – please use the bins provided.
5. **Supervise children** at all times and be considerate to other visitors.
6. **Please keep to the designated paths** around the arable fields and close gates.
7. **Please do not feed** grazing animals and wildlife.
8. **Cycling** is allowed on the concrete track from the West Cambridge/Coton Footpath to Wheatcases Barn only. Please use the cycle racks.
9. **Horse riding** is allowed along designated bridleways only (the bridleway from Barton and the grass permissive bridleway linking to the West Cambridge/Coton Footpath)
10. **Please be careful near open water** (unfenced ditches and ponds) no swimming, boating or fishing
11. **Enjoy the wildlife** but do not pick flowers or fruit, disturb wild animals or interfere with wildlife in any way.
12. The use of **metal detectors** is forbidden.
13. **No open fires or barbeques** are permitted.
14. **Please keep the Reserve tidy** – take your litter home.
