

# Wandlebury Country Park Rules

Please read and follow the rules below. They help to make this green space a happy and safer place for everyone to visit, and help to protect wildlife.

1. **Cars, motorbikes & other motorised vehicles** (except disabled buggies) must only use the visitor car park/disabled parking area.
2. **Camping and overnight stays of any vehicle, including caravans,** are not permitted.
3. **Dogs** must be kept under strict control and on leads at all times, to protect our wildlife, sheep and cattle, and fellow visitors.
4. **Clean up after your dogs** – please use the bins provided.
5. **Supervise children** at all times and be considerate to other visitors.
6. **Please keep to the designated paths** through the woods and close gates.
7. **Please do not enter meadows** where cattle and sheep are grazing.
8. **Please do not feed** the cattle or sheep and wildlife.
9. **No cycling** is allowed through the Park except for children under 8 years when accompanied by an adult. Please use the cycle racks.
10. **Horse riding** is not allowed.
11. **Please be quiet near any residential properties.**
12. **Please be careful near unfenced areas of open water** – no swimming, boating or fishing
13. **Enjoy the wildlife** but do not pick flowers or fruit, disturb wild animals or interfere with wildlife in any way.
14. The use of **metal detectors** is forbidden.
15. **No open fires** are permitted anywhere on site.
16. **No barbecues** are permitted, unless the designated BBQ area is pre-booked with the Head Ranger.
17. **Please keep the Park tidy** – take your litter home or use the bins provided.
